

## **Capacity Enhancement Grant Proposal 2016-2017**

The 2016-17 academic year will see several developments that will be supported by the Capacity Enhancement Grant.

Following last year's development plan, the entire faculty will continue to develop and implement the strategies designed for the Approaches to Teaching and Learning (ATL), to be externally evaluated by the IB 5 Year Review School Visit in April, 2017. As suggested in last year's report, some of these ATL skills would naturally enhance and/or supplement the promotion of positive education, which is one of the major themes for this year's college development. Hence, new and additional resources will be acquired to support this aim, to be covered by this year's grant.

In light of the development of different eLearning platforms in recent years, including (but not limited to) Denbigh, Haiku and ManageBac, it is time to evaluate each of them in order to centralize and standardize all ICT resources to improve and support an effective and efficient delivery of Learning and Teaching in and out of classes. Hence, an IT Developments Committee will be formed to review the existing platforms and IT facilities, investigate alternatives in the market and put together proposals for further developments to the entire college community. Such research will be funded by this year's grant as well.
